# Job Purpose

Responsible for installation, troubleshooting, programming, testing, and inspection of fire alarm systems District Wide.

# **Description of Duties and Tasks**

Essential duties and responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

#### Required

- 1. Inspects buildings for code compliance. Identifies and corrects hazards.
- 2. Performs annual inspections and preventative maintenance services on fire alarm systems.
- 3. Installs, modifies, maintains, programs and repairs fire alarm panels.
- 4. Investigates, reports and responds to emergency calls.
- 5. Installs pull stations, smoke detectors, and duct detectors.
- 6. Carries a pager and responds to emergencies after hours, weekends, and holidays.
- 7. Complies with all applicable health and safety regulations, policies, and established work practices.

### Knowledge

Must possess required knowledge and be able to explain and demonstrate, with or without reasonable accommodations, that the essential functions of the job can be performed.
